Upon application of Ron O'Brien, Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney, and for good cause shown, pursuant to Section 2941.63, ORC, being of the opinion that it is in the public interest, the Court hereby appoints Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost, or any Assistants designated by him, as Special Assistant to the Prosecuting Attorney, in and for all matters involving the shooting death of Andre Hill on December 22, 2020, by a City of Columbus law enforcement officer. In executing such appointment, Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost or any Assistants designated by him, shall have the same powers and duties as other assistant prosecuting attorneys, including the power to appear before and present cases to the Franklin County Grand Jury, and to handle the case at trial and to conclusion.
