D. A GUILTY PLEA. I have reviewed and understand this plea agreement and I ask the Court to accept any motion of the Prosecutor to amend the existing Indictment or Bill of Information. I knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily withdraw my former plea of not guilty and enter a plea of guilty to the following offense(s): Count 1: Obstructing Justice, a misdemeanor of the first degree, ORC 2921.32(A)(4) Count 2: Obstructing Official Business, a misdemeanor of the second degree, ORC 2921.31(A) / (B); Count 3: Hazing, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree, ORC 2903.31(B)(1) / (C); Count 4: Hazing, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree, ORC 2903.31(B)(1) / (C); Count 5: Hazing, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree, ORC 2903.31(B)(1) / (C); Count 5: Hazing, a

E. ALWAIVER OF CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS. I understand that a plea of guilty is a complete admission of guilty and that if I plead guilty I give up my right to a jury trial or court trial where I could confront and have my attorney question witnesses against me and where I could use the power of the court to call witnesses to testify for me. I know at trial I would not have to take the witness stand and could not be forced to testify against myself and that no one could comment if I chose not to testify and the jury could not infer I was guilty because I did not testify. I know that I am presumed not guilty of any crime at this time, but the presumption is nullified if I plead guilty. I understand I waive my right to have the Prosecutor prove my guilt beyond a reasonable doubt by a trial before the judge or by a jury of my peers. I further understand that if convicted at a trial, I would have the full right of appeal, but if I plead guilty I would have a very limited right to appeal my sentence within 30 days of my sentence.

F. A EFFECT OF PLEA OF GUILTY. I further understand that if I plead guilty I will receive a sentence. The sentencing hearing may be today or continued to another date.

The Court may refer me to the probation department to have a pre-sentence report prepared

before the sentencing hearing. I understand that any recommendations are not binding on the Court and that no promises or guarantees as to sentence have been made to me.

I understand that if I am now on misdemeanor probation or under a community control sanction this plea may result in revocation proceedings and any new sentence could be imposed consecutively.

G. A MAXIMUM PENALTY. financial sanctions including fines, day fines, and reimbursement for the costs of any
sanctions may also be imposed upon me at sentencing.
J. ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS. I understand that for the offense to which I am
pleading guilty, the Judge may or <u>XXXX</u> may not, revoke my driving privileges or
impose a driving license suspension of no less than six months to five years.

K. A LPOST RELEASE CONTROL. Does not apply.

L.AL. COMMUNITY SANCTIONS.

1. I understand that since my sentence will be a mandatory prison sentence, I am not eligible to be sentenced to community control sanctions;

XXXX 2. Since this Court is not required by law to impose a jail sentence upon me, the Court may impose non-jail sanctions. A pre-sentence report is not necessary but can be requested by the parties and ordered by the judge. I understand that if I violate the terms or conditions of a community control sanction, the Court may extend the time for which I am subject to these sanctions up to a maximum of five years, impose more restrictive sanctions, or jail me for up to the maximum stated term allowed for the offense(s) as set out above.

M. ALJUDICIAL RELEASE. If a prison sentence is imposed upon you, the law XXXX does; or \_\_\_\_\_ does not; permit you to seek early judicial release. Whether early judicial release is granted is a decision for the judge to make after reconsidering the sentencing factors.

N. N. VOLUNTARY GUILTY PLEA. Pleading guilty is what I want to do. I have relied upon my attorney for advice but the decision to enter a plea of guilty is mine and not his. No threats have been made to me to induce me to enter a plea of guilty. No promises have been made to me as to the sentence to be imposed by the Court and further no other promises have been made to me except as a part of the plea agreement.
