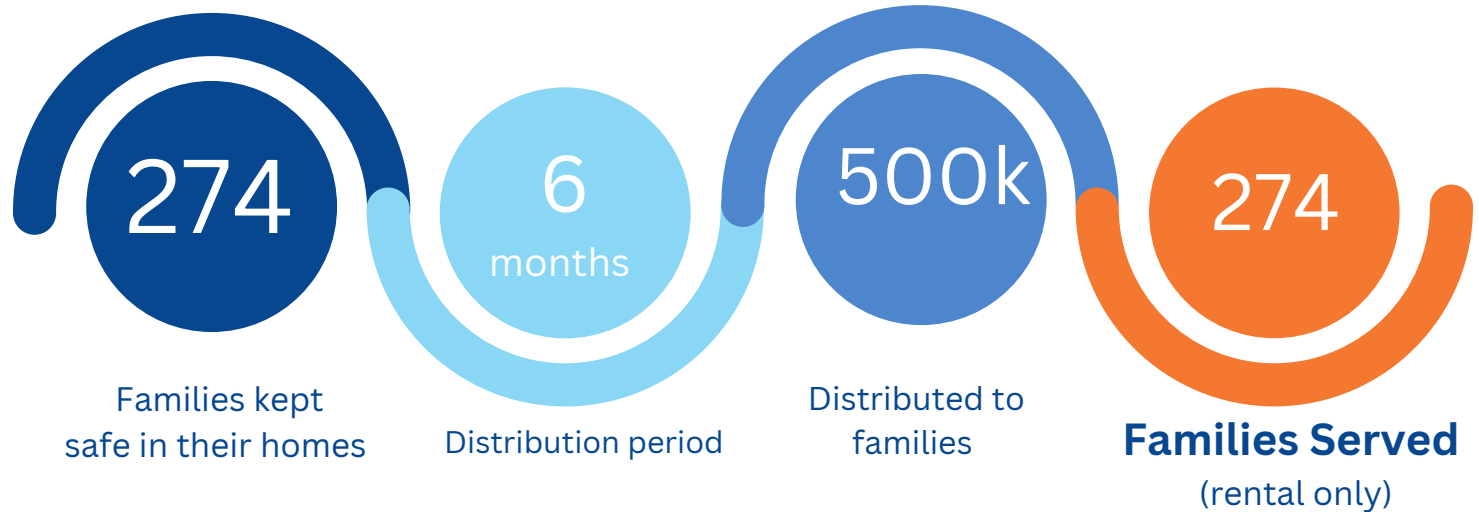

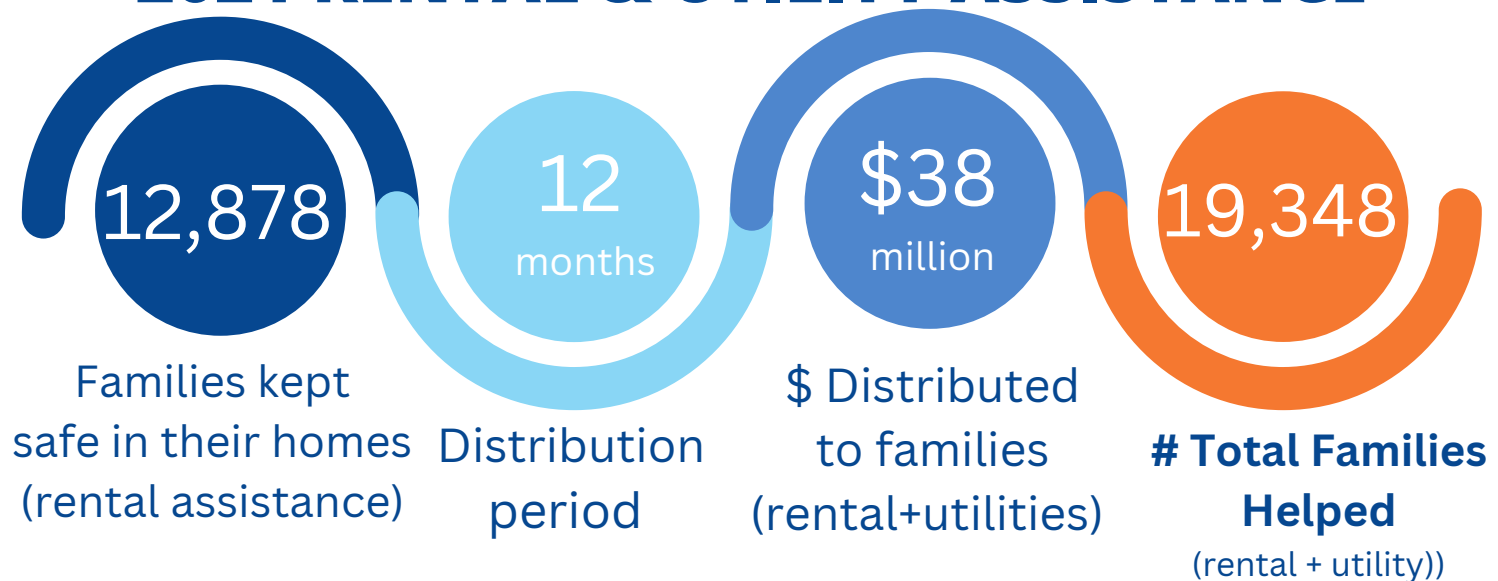

2020 RENTAL ASSISTANCE BY THE NUMBERS

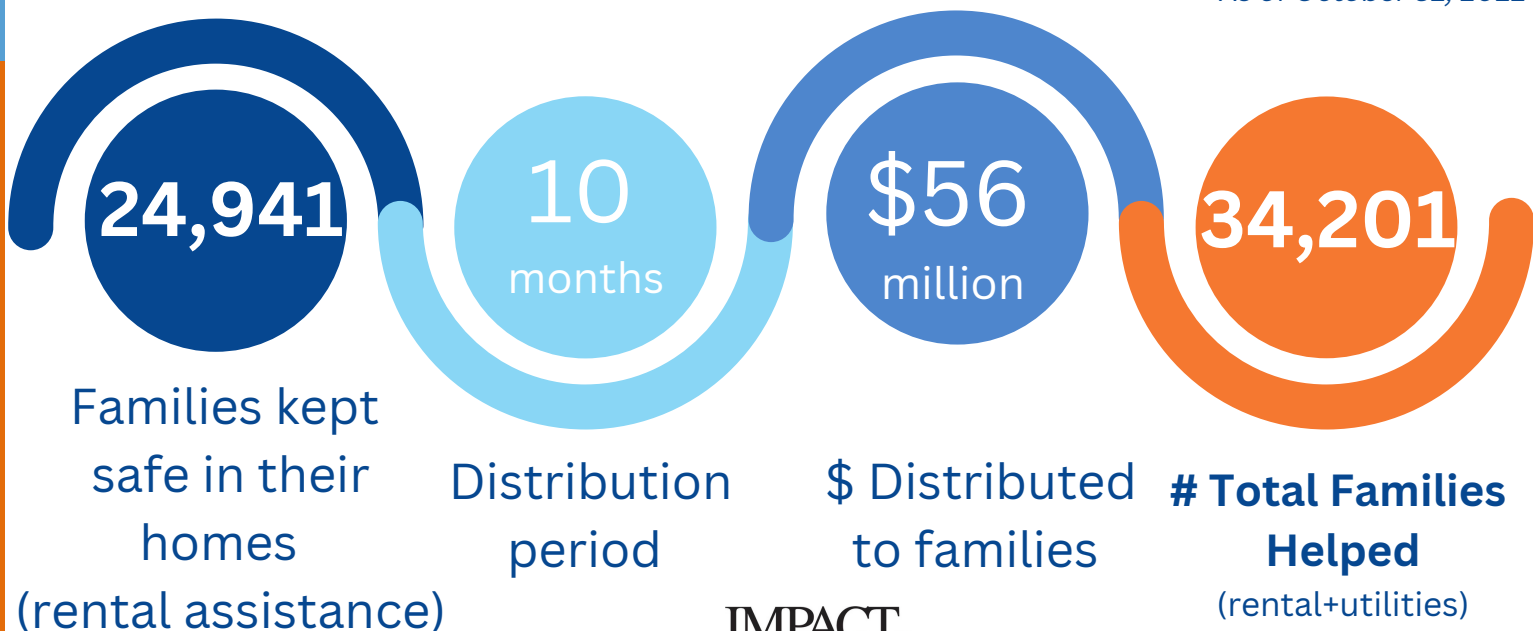


2021 RENTAL & UTILITY ASSISTANCE

EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE (ERA): WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2023 AT IMPACT

In 2023, there will be a 90% decrease in IMPACT's ERA funding (funding designated for emergency rental assistance).

There is still \$360 million in ERA funding available at the state level, but IMPACT does not have access to those funds.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

THE CURRENT ERA RENTAL PORTAL WILL SUSPEND OPERATIONS ON DECEMBER 14, 2022. ALL ERA RENTAL APPLICATIONS CURRENTLY IN THE QUEUE WILL BE ADDRESSED.

ONCE PORTAL OPERATIONS ARE SUSPENDED, ALL INQUIRIES WILL BE SENT TO THE STATE ERA FUNDING PORTAL:
