


Board Policy 7105

Coming Up

- Month of May Community forums, surveys and gallery walks to gather community input on initial recommendations
- Month of June Target for final recommendation(s) presentation to Board of Education for vote at Board Meeting



Scenario Criteria

- Increase more equitable service delivery opportunities across the district
- Increase access to additional academic and extracurricular programming
- Standardize grade levels
- Honor prior taxpayer investments
- Consider all areas of the district for consolidation options
